- Composition book
- Drawing tablet or sketch pad - 8.5x11 in.
- Pencil box
- 4 glue sticks
- 2 boxes of pre-sharpened #2 pencils
- 2 pink rectangular erasers - students are also welcome to have pencil topper erasers but would need more than 2
- 24-count box of crayons OR colored pencils
- 1 pack of washable markers
- Washable watercolor paint pallet
- 1 pair of child scissors, blunt or sharp tip (parent may choose)
- 2 highlighters - any color, but lighter is best (yellow, lime green, or orange)
- Refillable water bottle
- Ruler with centimeters and inches
- 2 boxes of tissues
- Ziplock bags - girls bring quart-sized and boys bring gallon-sized
- Laundry basket for storage of personal items
- Small, easily portable lawn chair for outside book work
- Optional:
 - Construction paper
